- In Industry they borrowed Italian machineries and depreciation charged at 10-12% P.A
- The company total turnover is 30-40 corers per annum.
- The company also pays GST (Goods and service Tax) at 18%.
- Raw material is purchased from kottalavadi, Arkalavadi, Hossur and Tamilnadu.
- Industry exports 100% materials to USA and Europe.
- 150 Working employees in the Industry.
- Power bill of factory is Rs-15, 00,000/- per month.
- Total salary expenses 17,50,000/-.P.M.

Details of programme

Age limit: One who completed 21 years can apply for both UPSC and KPSC jobs.

Education Qualification: Any degree holder from recognized universities irrespective of arts, science and commerce can apply. Common subjects and syllabus for exams: Usually UPSC and KPSC exams have the following subjects:

- 1. History:It includes Ancient history, medieval history, India during independence, India after independence, Karnataka history, Cultural history and contribution. Around 8-10 questions will arise from history.
- 2. Political science: It includes Indian politics, Indian constitution, Public commission, Basic rights and duties of President and Prime minister. Around 10-15 question we expect from this subject.
- 3. Geography: It includes Physical geography, Human geography, and Indian and Karnataka geography. Nearly 15-20 questions will come from this subject.
- 4. Economics:It includes Banking sectors, RBI rules, GST and Taxation, Budget and fiscal policy of the country. We expect 10 questions in this subject.
- 5. General Science: It includes Chemical science, Space science, Computer science, Biological science and applied science. 3-4 questions will arise from this subject.

All the above 5 subjects' covers nearly 60% of the syllabus. Remaining 40% of the Syllabus includes General Knowledge, Mental ability, Current Events and Affairs.

Along with the above information he also provide the information about the books and apps from play store for references and along with the various groups to be follow in social media like in Telegram we may join the group Mahithi Vedike for current updates etc. He asks the students to refer state syllabus books from 5^{th} to 10^{th} standards' and NCERT books from 8^{th} to 12^{th} standards. Finally he concludes that apart from the above to get success in competitive exams hard work and dedication is more important.
