

5. Special Lecture program on - Human Values and Professional Ethics

On 28.06.2022, The Bharath Scouts and Guides Rangers unit in association with IQAC organized a special lecture on "**Human Values and Professional Ethics**". Miss Sushmitha P and Miss Megha, III BCA, invocated the program. Miss Mythri, I BCOM warmly welcomed the gathering. The lecture was attended by BCA, BBA, BCOM and BSc students and the staff. The lecture was delivered by Dr. Sudarshana H M, Faculty, Human Resource Development, Mysore.

Dr Sudarshana H M started by distinctly defining KAS as Knowledge, Attitude, Skill. He recalled that KAS stands for Karnataka Administrative Service. Anyone who masters a subject, develop a positive attitude and enhance his skills have more chances of clearing the competitive exams. He noted that the ego of a person is the biggest threat to his personal, professional life. Ego affects the mental and physical health and leads to stress and depression. Basic human values refer to those values which are at the core of being human. The values which are considered basic inherent values in humans include truth, honesty, loyalty, love, peace, etc. Because they bring out the fundamental goodness of human beings and society at large. He narrated Swami Vivekananda, Mother Theresa, Sri Lal Bahadur Shasthriji's stories and examples to explain the importance of human values and how one can master his mind by practicing good human values.

Dr. Sudarshana H M stated that, professional ethics is nothing but a code of conduct applicable to different professions and is set up by the expert members of such profession or professional organizations. According to Dr. Sudarshana H M, every person strives to join their desired service, but only a few are successful. A job is a privilege because it gives status, honour, and social respect. It also gives life economic security. He opinioned that one can choose to use his position for good, bad, or inaction. Dr. Sudarshana H M remarked that every area of service has its own purpose and objectives and it is our duty to ensure that the objectives of our respective work/duty are fulfilled.

As per Dr. Sudarshana H M, as the world is becoming more materialistic, human values and professional ethics are diminishing their significance. The education ministry of India has launched numerous programmes under the New Education Policy in an effort to inculcate moral principles and professional ethics in young people. In his remarks, Mr. R M Swamy, the public relational officer, discussed the significance of joint families and human values. He said that if a woman upholds decent human principles, then the rest of the family will do the same.

The principal, Mr. Mariswamy K S, stated in his presidential address that ethics and values help people realise that their actions have an impact on both themselves and other people. Ethics and values enhance credibility, leadership abilities, decision-making, and long-term benefits. Values and ethics contribute in achieving fundamental human needs.
