An **Anti -Ragging And Anti- Women Harassment Cell** was formed headed by the Principal, and a Police, Advocate, Teaching and Non-teaching faculty, hostel warden and also students representatives as members. The college has 868 students strength during the academic year 2022-23. The college has been arranging many programmes in order to bring awareness among the students by this cell every year.

The cell actively conducts the activities related to Anti-Ragging and Anti- Women Harassment: namely making students to fill the Anti-Ragging undertaking forms through online, through the help of mentors-Mentees system. The Committee members along with the Convener take the initiative of addressing the students by going to each class separately exclusively to make each student feel comfortable and secured.

The committee organized a special lecture programme on 'Gender equity' in order to educate and bring awareness on sexual harassment among the students and working women on 11.01.2023.

The Anti -Ragging and Anti-women harassment cell organized an awareness Program "Road Safety and Social concern "in collaboration with District Police, Chamarajanagar, on 21.01.2023 to create awareness to student about traffic rules. The students took out a Jatha to create awareness among students a few pamphlets, wall papers etc were displayed at various prime locations. Also the students are encouraged to discuss their problems and solutions under this cell.

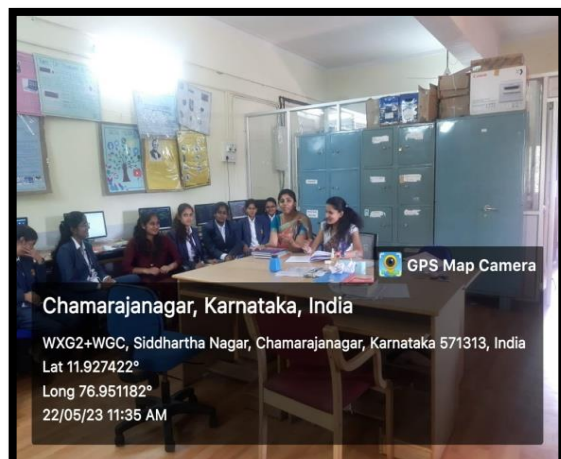
GIST OF THE PROGRAMME

The resource person expressed that in India one and half lakhs of people lost their lives due to accidents in the year 2021. Mistakes committed by the people are responsible for such accidents. He said that the road accidents can be reduced when the vehicle rider knows the traffic rules and follow them properly. He also explained the reasons for accidents such as rash driving, consumption of alcohol, using mobile phones while driving, over loading of people or things, driving without headlights, not following the traffic rules. Accident or death affects not only the person concerned but also his family and others. The resource person gave guidelines to the student about safety rules and suggested for careful driving.

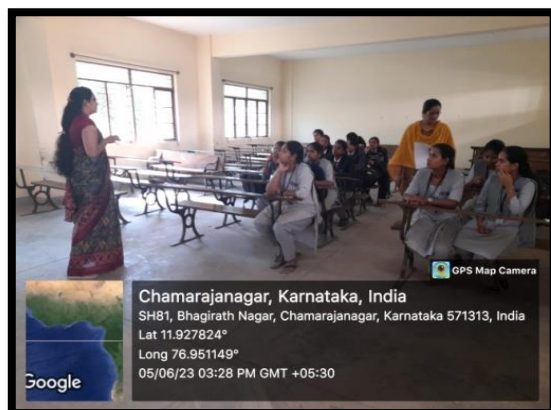
