Anti-Ragging Cell

Special lecture: Prevention of Ragging and Its Legal Provisions"

On 25.11.2024, a special lecture program on the topic "Prevention of Ragging and Its Legal Provisions" was organized by the Anti-Ragging Cell.

The program was invocated with a prayer by Kum. Bhoomika J, III B.Sc. student. The Anti-Ragging Cell Co-ordinator and Head of the Department of Chemistry, Kum. Sowmya M, welcomed the gathering. In her address, she stated that the program was organized to raise awareness against Ragging. She emphasized that ragging is not a matter of fun; rather, it is an activity filled with harassment, which can cause mental and emotional distress to the victims, affecting their lives significantly. She pointed out that both the Supreme Court and the UGC have implemented strict regulations to prevent Ragging. According to the law, Ragging is a punishable offense, and those involved in such activities are liable to face consequences. She opined that creating awareness about this issue is our responsibility and that such initiatives contribute to fostering equality, safety, and a friendly environment for students in educational institutions.

Kum. Shwetha S, an Advocate, District Court, Chamarajanagar, delivered the special lecture. She stated that Ragging is a criminal offense that causes mental harassment to students and disrupts their focus on academics. She highlighted that humiliation, forced actions, physical abuse, and social harassment are significant characteristics of Ragging. Such acts can even lead to extreme consequences like suicides and create an atmosphere of fear on campus. She explained that Ragging is legally prohibited, and offenders are punishable under (SECTIONS 506,323,325,326 and 294) of the Indian Penal Code. She also elaborated on the responsibilities of educational institutions and introduced some new legal provisions. She emphasized that the fight against ragging is not just a legal obligation but also essential for preserving human values.

Our College Principal, Dr. N. Mahadevaswamy, in his presidential address, remarked that harassment by seniors towards new students has become a serious issue in many places. Such incidents impact student minds and self-confidence, often causing them to lose interest in their studies. He stressed the importance of behaving ethically in daily interactions to ensure that our actions do not harm others. Seniors should interact with new students in a friendly manner. He also emphasized that adhering to UGC norms Anti-Ragging guidelines is mandatory.


The program was hosted by Kum. Prakruthi, II B.Sc. student, and Kum. Pallavi, III BCA student, proposed the vote of thanks.
